Conditions of entry

- Entries for the Qualifiers must be made on the official Riding Club Entry Forms from www.area17brc.org.uk/area-qualifiers and be accompanied by photocopies of horse passports to show full vaccination record. Passports can also be uploaded to Area 17's passport database. Emailed copy of passports will be accepted. The original certificates must be available to be produced on the day.
- Each riding club making a qualifier entry must provide the names and contact details of helpers. 1 helper all day or 2 for half a day each. Details to be sent on form.

- British Riding Club Rules 2019 will apply
- Any protest against a decision of the judges should be made in accordance with riding club rule G14 of 2019 rule book. Appendix 4 of BRC rulebook.
- Hard hat with fixed straps, harnessed properly, adjusted and fastened (Riding Club Rules 2019) to be worn at all times when mounted and meet the following standards. Hats will be checked and tagged at this competition. Please allow extra
- time for this process.

- The organisers reserve the right to retain a proportion of the entry fee for administration purposes in the event of cancellation of the competition.
- The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers Officials and Stewards.
- Entry fees will not be returned unless a vet or doctor certificate is provided.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter the order of classes to ease travel arrangements for competitors travelling from the Isle of Wight

- Substitutions: In the event of withdrawals, substitutions will be allowed. The deadline for complex substitutions will be by Tuesday 1st October 2019, 1800hrs. A complex substitution is one where teams are re-arranged or horse and rider combinations are moved from one team to another. Simple substitutions are ones where a horse and/or rider replaces the withdrawn one in the same team and position.
