

RULES

This competition will be run in accordance with the Riding Club Rules for Competitions, 2020.

British Riding Clubs, Crofton Manor Equestrian Centre and persons acting on their behalf, do not accept any liability for any loss, accident, or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or goods occurring in connection with this event. It is a condition of entry that each competitor indemnifies the organiser against any claim.

Entry for Qualifying Classes is open to all affiliated Riding Clubs in Area 17. Competitors only are permitted to ride the horse on the showground. Lungeing is NOT permitted on the Showground.

Correctly Tagged 'Protective Headwear' must be worn at all times by anyone riding anywhere at a BRC event. Harnesses must be correctly adjusted and fastened. 'Protective Headwear' constitutes a hat which meets one of the following standards. Failure to do so will incur elimination.

British	PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked (Also Euro&American) VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked
European	VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked
American	ASTM F1163; 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001 and SNELL E2016
Australian & New Zealand	AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked

Head cams are not permitted at this event. Body Protectors must be a BETA Level 3 displaying EITHER a Purple 2009 label OR Blue 2018 Label.

Competitors must report to the steward and be ready to ride up to 10 minutes before the allotted time.

PASSPORT/VACCINATION CERTIFICATES – The Passport/vaccination Certificate must, under penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to all official competitions, the competitor is responsible for producing it on demand.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers and land-owners have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the Organisers, officials and stewards, and take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring. First Aid cover will be provided.

No animal is to be tied up outside boxes or trailers and left unattended.

BRC Area 17 Combined Training Qualifier for Seniors and Juniors.

Comprises two phases, dressage and show jumping. Refer to the 2020 Rule Book for more information.

Teams of four, best three scores to count. Two Team members compete in a Prelim (BE90)/75 section (each riding a different Test) and two in a Novice (BE100)/85 section (each riding a different Test).

There are also 2 extra Individual Only Sections comprising Novice/75 and Prelim/85 (Classes 3 and 6).

A horse may enter the combined training as part of a Team and also enter once as an Individual or twice as an Individual, providing the 'Dressage Test' is different. The SJ height may be either 75cms or 85cms, therefore a horse can jump the same height twice.

Class 1 - BE90 Dressage 91(2009)/75cms Show Jumping
Class 1a Senior/Class1b - Juniors

Class 2 - BE90 Dressage 95 (2012)/75cms Show Jumping
Class 2a Senior/Class 2b Junior

Class 3 - BE100 Dressage 106 (2012)/75cms Show Jumping
Class 3a Senior/Class 3b Junior – **Extra Class for Individual's ONLY**

Class 4 – BE100 Dressage 101 (2009)/85cms Show Jumping
Class 4a Senior/Class 4b Junior

Class 5 – BE100 Dressage 102 (2010)/85cms Show Jumping
Class 5a Senior/Class 5b Junior

Class 6 – BE90 Dressage 96 (2016)/85cms Show Jumping
Class 6a Senior/Class 6b Junior – **Extra Class for Individual's ONLY**

All show jumping speeds 325 metres per minute

Entry Fees: Teams - £140 : Individuals - £35.00

Please make cheques payable to **"Chilworth Riding Club"**.

Insurance: All Riding Club members are covered by third party insurance. Any one attending the event who is NOT a riding club member should take out their own Third Party Insurance.

Helpers: All Riding Clubs must provide at least one helper per Team for the day or two helpers for half a day – one morning, one afternoon. Team Managers must provide helper details on the Helpers Form – this must accompany the Detailed Entry Form - and specify a preferred job and experience. Failure to provide the correct number of helpers may result in a Club being disqualified from the Qualifier.

Preliminary Entries to: British Riding Clubs Office by Thursday 19 March 2020. Entries can be made on-line via BHS Shop.

Detailed Entries and Helpers Form to Entries Secretary: Karen Morton, Oakbank 96 Rolleston Road, Holbury, Southampton, SO45 2GZ by Wednesday 1 April 2020. Please ensure all Passports are on the Area 17 Passport Database by Wednesday 1 April. If this is not possible a legible copy of each horses Passport including description, markings and full flu vaccination record (to include 1-2-3 vacs) must either accompany the Detailed Entry Form or be emailed* to karenamorton@hotmail.co.uk emails still to be received by Wednesday 1 April 2020. Entry forms can be downloaded from www.area17-brc.org.uk. *Scan the pages from each Passport into one Word Document File for each Passport/flu vaccination to be emailed. If this cannot be done, please post with Detailed Entry Form.

Times: Will be posted on the Chilworth Riding Club website www.chilworthrc.co.uk and Area 17 web site www.area17-brc.org.uk by Wednesday 8 April 2020.

Substitutions: In the event of withdrawals, substitutions will be allowed. The deadline for complex substitutions will be by **Monday 6 April**, 1800 hours. Please email karenamorton@hotmail.co.uk or phone **07719 863618**. Late simple substitutions may be made at the time teams are declared. A complex substitution is one where teams are re-arranged or horse and rider combinations are moved from one team to another. Simple substitutions are ones where a horse and/or rider replaces the withdrawn one in the same team and position.

Declarations: Must be made by Team Managers 30 minutes before the start of competition on Friday 10 April 2020. Emailed Declarations can only be accepted by prior arrangement with the Entries Secretary.

Directions from Southampton: Coming from Southampton leave the M27 at Junction 9, then at roundabout take the 5th exit onto the A3051 (signposted Fareham West). At roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A27, signposted Fareham (Local landmark: TGI Fridays). At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A27. (Local landmark: Holiday Inn). Stay in the right-hand lane and bear right onto Titchfield Road - B3334. Crofton Manor Equestrian Centre is about 1.4 mile down the road on the right.
