Classes will probably run in this order, but we may need to change the order based on the numbers of entries. All classes are run in accordance with **British Riding Club Rules**, horses/ponies must be at least 4 years old.

**Class 1A 70cm SJ & Cross-country fences max 70cm. SJ speed 340mpm**  
Cross-Country speed of 400m/min. Entry fee: Individual £48.00 (Inc vat and £4.00 first aid) Combined Challenge, a mixed class (seniors and/or juniors) for teams and individuals

**Class 2A Junior 80cm SJ & Cross-country fences max 80cm. SJ speed 340mpm**  
Cross-Country speed of 435m/min. Entry fee: Individual £48.00 (Inc vat and £4.00 first aid)

**Class 2B Senior 80cm SJ & Cross-country fences max 80cm. SJ speed 340mpm**  
Cross-Country speed of 435m/min. Entry fee: Individual £48.00 (Inc vat and £4.00 first aid)

**Class 3A Junior 90cm SJ & Cross-country fences max 90cm. SJ speed 340mpm**  
Cross-Country speed of 450m/min. Entry fee: - Individual £48.00 (Inc vat and £4.00 first aid)

**Class 3B Senior 90cm SJ & Cross-country fences max 90cm. SJ speed 340mpm**  
Cross-Country speed of 450m/min. Entry fee: - Individual £48.00 (Inc vat and £4.00 first aid)

**Class 4A 100cm SJ & Cross-country fences max 100cm. SJ speed 340mpm**  
Cross-Country speed of 475m/min. Entry fee: Individual £48.00 (Inc vat and £4.00 first aid), a mixed class (seniors and/or juniors) for teams and individuals
