## **Class 1: Intro A (2008)**

*Horses must have 0 BD points at Novice or above*

## **Class 2: Prelim 12 (2005\*)Restricted/Open)**

*Horses must have 0 BD points at Novice or above.*

## **Class 3: Novice 27 (2007)**

*Horses may have up to 35 Elementary BD points but 0 BD points at Medium or above.*

## **Class 4: PYO:**

### **a) Novice 39 (2010\*)**

*Horses may have up to 35 Elementary BD points but 0 BD points at Medium or above.*

### **b) Elementary 43 (2006)**

*Horses may have up to 35 Medium BD points but 0 BD points at Adv Medium or above.*

### **c) Medium 69 (2005)**

*Horses may have up to or 35 Adv Med BD points but 0 BD points at PSG or above.*

*\*These tests were revised in 2016, but only to standardise all collectives*

**Please indicate which test you will be riding in the Class Notes field on-line or on the entry form.**

*The arena will be adjusted to 20m x 60m for Class 4.*

### ***Preliminary/Restricted Section:***

Horse and Rider combinations who have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in a dressage competition do not qualify to ride in the Restricted section.

Horse and Rider combinations who have competed at Elementary Level or BE Novice Horse Trials do not qualify to ride in the Restricted section.

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers, the landowner and his agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses or ponies howsoever caused on the premises.
2. These competitions will be run in accordance with the Riding Club Rulebook 2017. All tests are available from British Dressage on 02476 698830 or from their website [www.britishdressage.co.uk](http://www.britishdressage.co.uk).
3. Competitors who are not British Riding Club members should carry their own Third Party Liability insurance.
4. Protective Headwear' must be worn at all times when mounted, with harness correctly adjusted and fastened. 'BRC Rulebook 2017 recommends that Protective Headwear should meet one of the following:

<b>British</b>	<b><i>PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked</i></b>
<b>European</b>	<b><i>VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked</i></b>
<b>American</b>	<b><i>ASTM F1163; 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001 or SNELL 2016</i></b>
<b>Australian &amp; New Zealand</b>	<b><i>AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked</i></b>

5. The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made in writing within 20 minutes of the said offence to the show organisers accompanied by a £20 deposit. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
6. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or alter classes. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be made less £3 per entry form to cover administration costs.
7. No entry fee will be refunded without a doctors or vets certificate and a stamped self-addressed envelope sent to the entries secretary within 14 days of the date of the competition.
8. Absolutely no telephone entries.
9. All horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
10. No horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in any class.
11. No lungeing permitted.

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY**
