GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR THE SHOW

1. The Judges decision shall be final.
2. No horse and pony under the age of four years may compete in a ridden class
3. All competitors are to wear protective headgear of a minimum standard of PAS 015 or EN 1384 at all times when mounted. We recommend back protectors to the appropriate standard for jumping.
4. Any objection is to be made within 20 minutes of the incident together with a £10 deposit (refundable if objection upheld).
5. Anyone seen abusing a horse or pony on the show ground will be asked to leave. No cantering/galloping outside of the rings in the show area.
6. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, or ask any person to leave the show ground, without giving a reason.
7. SVRC has taken the necessary precautions to avoid classes clashing, but the ultimate responsibility is with the competitor. SVRC will not give refunds for classes missed in this way.
8. **DO NOT** "muck out" lorries/trailers on the show ground. Anyone seen doing so will be asked to remove the muck and leave the show ground.
9. In the event of bad weather it is the responsibility of the competitor to contact the organiser – Helen Blunn (07973 920157).
10. Dogs must be on a lead and under control at all times.
11. No horse or pony may compete more than once in any class excluding clear round show jumping and handy pony.
12. Dressage will be run under British Riding Club Rules. Tests maybe read from E or B position.
