PRIZE GIVING WILL BE DISMOUNTED AND HELD AT THE SECRETARY CABIN

Please note that depending on entry numbers, daylight hours and to allow for our Isle of Wight teams, the classes may not run in this order and we may also have to change the proposed Arena. Details will be clearly given when times are issued.

RULES

- 1, The competition will be run in accordance with the official rules for all British Riding Clubs Competitions 2019.**
- 2. In order to qualify for the relevant British Club Championships, entries must be made through clubs on the official forms.**
- 3. It is the sole responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their horse has a valid Flu Vaccination record. Team Managers must send a copy of the record with the Area entry (see Entry Requirements)**
- 4. Competitors only are allowed to ride the horse on the showground and riders must wear a correctly “tagged” hard hat with the harness adjusted and fastened at all times**
- 5. Lungeing is NOT permitted on the Showground under any circumstances**
- 6. Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times, and young children properly supervised**
- 7. In the event of adverse weather conditions it is the responsibility of the Team Managers to seek confirmation of the cancellation of the event. It will be published on www.purbeckridingclub.co.uk asap or 07880973984 (please do NOT text or leave a message as it may be missed)**

Prelim Entries are to be made by the team manager to the BRC office on the official entry form or on- line by **Saturday 26TH January 2019**. Cheques to BRC or on-line payment (21 days before the competition)

IMPORTANT - PLEASE NOTE THAT ANY ENQUIRIES MUST BE MADE BY THE TEAM MANAGER ONLY

Entry forms must be accompanied by the relevant passport pages (these must show the horses name, passport number, silhouette and written description, plus **FULL** vaccination record) **Passport information can be sent by e-mail BUT ONLY IN PDF Format and the must be LEGIBLE to kizzierussell@hotmail.co.uk**

If sent by post, team organisers must initial and date the flu vaccination record as a verification that they have checked it and it is correct. Where applicable please indicate where the last sequence starts. Please ensure each record is stapled together to prevent loss and/or mixed up pages.

ORIGINAL PASSPORTS MUST BE BROUGHT ON THE DAY AS "RANDOM" CHECKING WILL BE CARRIED OUT

HELPERS

Each participating club will be required to provide names and contact details of 1 helper (full day) or 2 helpers (half day) for each team(s) is/are entered. The relevant form will be sent to each participating Club and MUST be returned with the entry form.

HATS

In accordance with 2019 rules all hats must be tagged with the current AQUA tag.

Tagging will be at the Secretaries Office

RIDERS

must report to the ring stewards for a tack check at least 20 mins before their start time (please allow enough time before your warm up)

TEAM DECLARATIONS

Must be made at least 30 minutes before the start of the class after which the competitor numbers will be issued, NO changes can be made after this.

SUBSTITUTIONS

In the event of a withdrawal, substitutions will be allowed. The deadline for complex substitutions will be mid-day Wednesday 13th February. Late simple substitutions, which must be in writing, may be made at the time teams are declared.

Passports for ALL horse substitutions must be produced to the secretary when making changes. That means for complex substitutions by 13th February (on-line), and for simple changes passports must be shown to the secretary on the day.

A complex substitution is one where teams are re-arranged or horse and rider combination are moved from one team to another. Simple ones are where a horse and/or rider replace(s) the withdrawn one in the SAME team and position.
