Senior Intermediate – Team and Individuals

- Class 1 – Prelim 18 (2002)**
- Class 2 – Novice 28 (2008)**
- Class 3 – Novice 30 (2006)**
- Class 4 – Elementary 42 (2008)**

For teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count and for individuals (all team members are automatically in the individual competition). One rider will ride a Prelim test, two riders will ride different Novice tests and one rider will ride an Elementary test.

Junior Intermediate – Team and Individuals

- Class 5 – Prelim 14 (2006)**
- Class 6 – Prelim 18 (2002)**
- Class 7 – Novice 28 (2008)**
- Class 8 – Novice 30 (2006)**

For teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count and for individuals (all team members are automatically in the individual competition). Two team riders will ride different Prelim tests and the other two team members will ride different Novice tests. One Novice test will have Elementary criteria.

Junior Elementary- Individuals

- Class 9 – Elementary 42 (2008) for junior individuals only**

Pick a Test Dressage- Individuals

For individuals, open to senior and juniors competing at either Medium or Advanced Medium. Competitors may compete in both Medium and Advanced Medium sections. Class 10 and 11 will be **judged as one** class at qualifier but maybe split at Championships if entries are sufficient.

Competitor numbers

Competitors must supply their own. Saddle or bridle numbers must be displayed on BOTH sides

Substitutions

In the event of withdrawals, substitutions will be allowed. The deadline for complex substitutions will be by Wed 13th MARCH at 6pm. Simple substitutions may be made on the day.

A complex substitution is one where teams are re-arranged or horse & rider combinations are moved from one team to another. Simple substitutions are ones where a horse & or rider replaces the withdrawn one in the same team & position.

Withdrawals from Non Qualifier Event

Withdrawals from the non-qualifier competition will only be refunded if made BEFORE the entry closing deadline of 9th March. Any withdrawals after this date will not be refunded.

Tack

It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure their tack and equipment confirms to the rules. Full details in the current BRC handbook

Lorry Park

Parking attendants will be on site throughout the day. Please ensure you follow their directions to allow enough room for everybody. Please remove ALL HAY, DROPPINGS AND LITTER from the lorry park and take home with you. Leave the venue in the same condition you would like to find it.

Medical Cover

Insurance

BRC Riding Club members are covered by third party insurance. Anyone attending the event who is NOT a riding club member should take out their own Third-Party Insurance.

Rules

- The competition will be run according to BRC rules 2024. Area 17, Meon Riding Club and persons acting on their behalf do not accept any liability for any loss, accident or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or goods occurring in connection with this event. It is a condition of entry that each competitor indemnifies the organiser against any claim.
- To qualify for the BRC championship entries must be made through clubs on the official forms.
- Competitors only are allowed to ride their horse on the showground. Everyone must wear a hard hat with the harness adjusted and fastened.
- Passport copies must be held on the Area 17 database – no need to send again with entries.
- Passport /vaccination certificates must under penalty of elimination accompany the horse. The competitor is responsible for producing it on demand.
- Flu vaccination record must comply with the 2024 BRC policy – currently annual vaccinations. All BRC horse passports will be checked on the shared drive to ensure compliance.
- Any protest against a decision of the judges should be made in accordance with riding club rule book
- **Protective headwear for all competitors in all classes must comply with BRC rules 2024.** All competitors in the qualifying classes must ensure their hat is tagged by the Official Steward and carries a PINK tag
- Under BRC rules, **any rider who has a fall from their horse anywhere on the showground CANNOT participate further in the competition that day.** This includes falls in the warm up arena or Lorry Park. Any breach of this rule will be reported to the Official Steward. Team managers are responsible for making sure all riders understand and accept this rule.
- Saddle or bridle numbers must be displayed on BOTH sides
- **Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times and not left unattended.** Anyone in breach of this rule may be asked to leave the showground.
- The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and shall obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.
- It is a condition of entry that neither the organisers nor landowners nor their agents shall be held responsible for any loss, injury, damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, horses or ponies, howsoever caused.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, judges, times or any other published information. In the event of cancellation, a proportion of entry fees will be retained for administration purposes.
